
محضرات توعوية

SOUND PROPAGATION USING LASER BEAM

Our grade 11 students Mohammad Al Hashmi, Hassan Folad and Abdulrahman Al Rumaithi, under the guidance of Mr. Monir ,participated in The Ministry of Education's, 4th edition of the National Science, Technology and Innovation, NSTI, Festival on 4th to 8th February 2020. Their project on "Sound Propagation Using Laser Beams" was awarded 2nd place in the competition. Our IPS project won the award out of 100 projects that were displayed for the competition.

The most important of which is the Emirates Young Scientist Competition, which attracted 2,472 projects submitted by 5,791 male and female students from 427 government and private schools.Out of all 2472 projects, our IPS project was selected.

The competition included projects on technology, biological sciences, environment, chemistry, physics, mathematics, and social and behavioral sciences. The variety of field topics represented enables students to participate later in specialized festivals and scientific events at international levels.
